Compliance with the Promotion of Access to Information Act 2 of 2000

The Independent Regulatory Board for Auditors (IRBA) would like to remind all firms of their obligation to comply with the Promotion of Access to Information Act 2 of 2000 (PAIA). Specifically, this reminder relates to the requirement to register each firm's Information Officer and submit the PAIA Annual Report, with the submissions due for filing with the Information Regulator by 30 June 2024.

In a concerted effort to assist the Information Regulator in promoting awareness and ensuring compliance across the board, we include hereto a series of documents that it has published. These offer firms guidance on compliance with the relevant PAIA requirements:

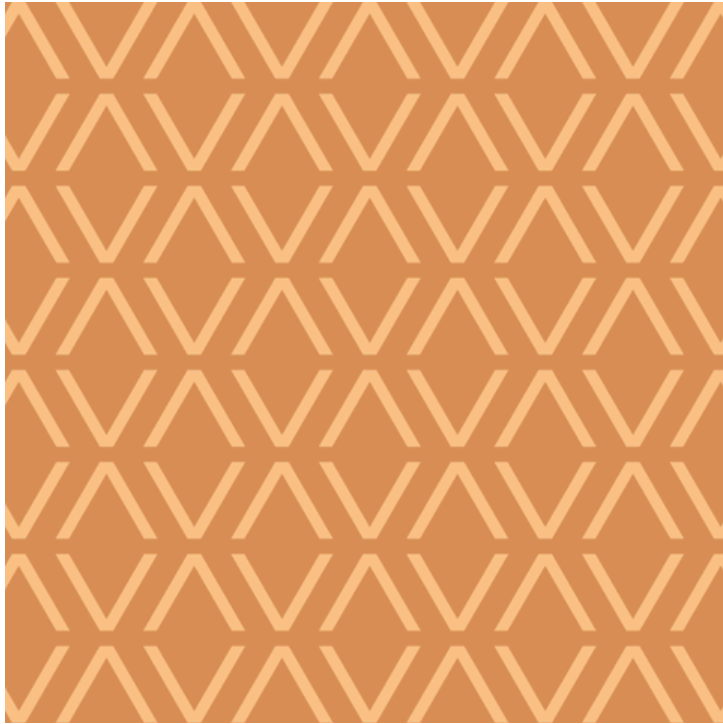
